Attention: Wisconsin High School Seniors

Is it your goal to play competitive hockey beyond high school? If so, read on!

The Minnesota Showcase replaces the old Chicago Showcase and be held April 23-25, 2010 in Plymouth, Minnesota. Team Wisconsin will select the top 20 qualifying high school seniors to represent our state at this event. As its name implies, the Minnesota Showcase will be one of the most heavily scouted high school tournaments in the United States. Your greatest opportunity to be exposed to scouts and coaches from all levels of hockey (junior, college, and even professional) could likely be at the Showcase! If you want to go to the “next level”, Team Wisconsin at the Minnesota Showcase may be your best bet.

In order to qualify there are rules that must be adhered to. In general, in order to qualify for the Showcase you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduating Wisconsin high school senior
- Compete in, at least, 70% of your team’s 2009-2010 games
- Be chosen to represent your section at and participate in the 2009-10 Wisconsin Senior Class Tournament in Waupun on March 26-28, 2010. Information on the Senior Tournament is posted on Wisconsin Prep Hockey website.
- Earn an invitation to and attend the 2010 Team Wisconsin Tryout Camp to be held April 2-3, 2010 in Stevens Point, WI (invitations will be made based on, among other factors, your performance at the Senior Class Tournament)
- Be selected to Team Wisconsin (20 players and alternates)
- Attend and participate in all Team Wisconsin 2010 functions including:
 - Team Wisconsin Training Camp, April 9-11, 2010 in TBA
 - “Pre-Showcase” practice on Sunday, April 18, 2010 in TBA
 - The Minnesota Showcase
